THE YORK WATER COMPANY APPOINTS ERIN C. CASEY AND JAMES H. CAWLEY AS NEW DIRECTORS

Hines, announced today that, the Board of Directors of The York Water Company appointed two new directors to the Board effective October 3, 2016. Ms. Erin C. Casey, founder and Partner at Design Quake, a design thinking consultancy in York, PA, and an adjunct professor of design thinking at York College of Pennsylvania, was appointed to a class of directors with terms expiring at the 2017 Annual Meeting of Shareholders.



President Hines stated that: "Ms. Casey brings experience in all aspects of running a business including strategic planning, marketing, production, finance, accounting, human resources, sales, and public relations. Her knowledge and experience will be invaluable and significantly aid the Board and its Committees in the areas of accounting and finance, strategic planning, and communications."

Prior to her current positions, Ms. Casey was on the senior management team at Rudy Art Glass, a family-owned decorative architectural glass fabricator in York, PA (2005-2016), an Assistant Marketing Manager for General Mills in Minneapolis, MN (2004-2005), Manager of Investment Funds at The Carlyle Group, a private equity firm in Washington, DC (1998-2002), and a Senior Auditor with Arthur Anderson LLP in Washington, DC (1995-1998). Ms. Casey holds a BS in Commerce Degree with a concentration in accounting from the University of Virginia, and an MBA from Stanford Graduate School of Business. In addition, Ms. Casey is involved in the community, currently serving as a Board member and Finance Committee member of The Cultural Alliance of York County, having previously served as a Board Member and Treasurer of Central Market, York, PA and Historic York, Inc. She was named a Central Penn Business Journal Woman of Influence in 2015, and a Woman of Distinction from Susquehanna Style in 2010.



James H. Cawley, former Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PPUC) Vice Chairman (2005-2008), Chairman (2008-2011) and Commissioner (2011-2015), was appointed to a class of directors with terms expiring at the 2019 Annual Meeting of Shareholders.

President Hines stated that: "Mr. Cawley brings a wealth of knowledge, insight, and experience in legal and regulatory matters, particularly within the state of Pennsylvania. He will be an invaluable asset to the Board of Directors and its Committees in the areas of customer rates, regulations and legislation in Pennsylvania, acquisitions, and many others. We are fortunate to be able to bring him on board."

In addition to his most recent PPUC positions, Mr. Cawley was previously a partner in several law firms including Rhoads & Sinon LLP, Harrisburg, PA (1996-2005) and LeBoeuf, Lamb, Green & MacRae LLP, Harrisburg PA office (1988-1996). Mr. Cawley also served as Chief Counsel to the Majority, Senate of Pennsylvania and Majority Counsel to the Consumer Affairs Committee early in his career. Mr. Cawley holds a BA in English from St. Bonaventure University, and a JD from the Notre Dame Law School. Mr. Cawley is a member of a number of Bars, is an adjunct professor of Administrative Law at the Widener University School of Law, Co-founder and Past President of the James S. Bowman American Inn of Court, a board member of the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court Historical Society, and a former member of the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners, having been Vice-Chairman of the Committee on Water.
