#### LIST OF CHANGES MADE BY THIS SUPPLEMENT

#### INCREASES

Base rates for water service are increased by approximately 28.9% overall. Average residential customer base rates are increased by approximately 30.7%, average commercial base rates are increased by approximately 32.5%, average industrial customer base rates are increased by approximately 34.5%, public fire service rates are increased by approximately 11.0%, and private fire service rates are increased by approximately 13.5%.

The State Tax Adjustment Surcharge is increased to 0.00% from (0.02%) on page 40.

#### DECREASES

The Distribution System Improvement Charge is decreased to (0.11%) from 3.19% on page 66.

#### 11. State Tax Adjustment Surcharge

12.1 In addition to the charges provided in this tariff, a surcharge of 0.00% (I) will apply to all charges for service rendered on or after August 1, 2025. (C)

The above surcharge will be recomputed, using the same elements prescribed by the Commission.

- a. Whenever any of the tax rates used in the calculation of the surcharge are changed; and
- b. Whenever the utility makes effective any increased or decreased rates.

The above recalculation will be submitted to the Commission within 10 days after the occurrence of the event or date which occasions such recomputation; and, if the recomputed surcharge is less than the one then in effect, the Company will, and if the recomputed surcharge is more than the one then in effect, the Company may, submit with such recomputation a tariff or supplement to reflect such recomputed surcharge, the effective date of which shall be 10 days after filing.

Applicable to a customer in the Residential Class that is added to the Company's service territory through an acquisition and does not have a meter at the customer's service address on the date of closing of such acquisition.

All water supplied by the Company under this rate schedule will be unmetered. However, the Company may install a meter of appropriate size at the customer's premise based on the Company's meter installation schedule as determined by the Company. Upon installation of a meter at the customer's service address by the Company, a customer will no longer be eligible for this rate schedule and will be charged a service charge based on the size of meter required to render adequate service along with a charge for consumption usage based upon the applicable metered rates in effect for the Residential Class.

The Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) shall not be applied to bills of water customers in Washington Township; this will remain in effect until an amended Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan (LTIIP) is filed and approved which includes Washington Township. Following the approval of an amended LTIIP, the DSIC surcharge shall be applicable to water customers in Washington Township.
